ADDITIONAL QUALIFYING PDH ACTIVITIES

- **FAA Drone Part 107** is considered as a qualifying PDH activity. Upon successful completion of the FAA Drone Part 107 exam 10 PDH credits may be reported.
[November 9, 2018 – Full Board Meeting]
- **International PDH Courses** may be considered as qualifying PDH activities, as long as it meets the criteria outlined in Section 16.39.2.7 of the New Mexico Administrative Code.
[August 11, 2017 - Full Board Meeting]
- **Certified Federal (CFED)** Surveyor training is allowed as a PDH activity. The CFED training may be used as a one-time use for fifteen (15) hours during the training portion and fifteen (15) hours upon completion of the certification.
[August 8, 2013 – Professional Surveying Committee Meeting]

QUALIFYING PDH ACTIVITIES

- Must have taken place during the reporting period (**January 1, 20XX through December 31, 20XX**)
- **New Licensees: PDHs are only eligible from the date of initial license to the expiration date.**
- Must have a clear purpose and objective which will maintain, improve, or expand the skills and knowledge relevant to the practice of engineering or surveying (courses taken only for personal use would not qualify)
- May include technical, ethical, or managerial content
- Should advance the professional or technical competence of the licensee
- May be sponsored by employers, government agencies, nationally affiliated engineering or surveying technical or professional societies, colleges or universities, or other organizations
- May be earned in any jurisdiction
- All other activities must comply with Title 16.39.2 of the Professional Development rules.
