The accredited engineering technology programs do not have any engineering mathematics (Cal III, Diff. Equations, Linear Algebra, Probability), they are algebra based programs - (some of them have two calculus courses - most of them have one calculus course).

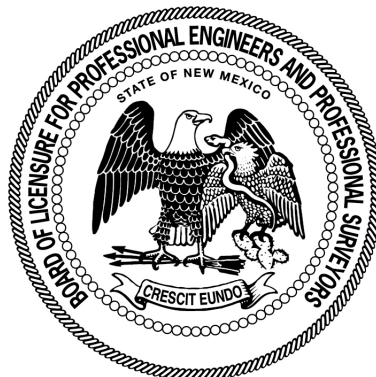
So, my opinion DO NOT recognize engineering technology degrees as more and more universities are converting such programs to engineering.
