f. 16.39.7 NMAC – Misc.

The Board disused this item at length and Ms. Joe informed the Board that if the applicant, or renewal licensee, was convicted of one of the crimes listed, they have to disclose it. She explained, if an applicant or licensee was convicted of a crime that is not on the list, they do not have to disclose it, for example if insurrection is not on the list, then they do not have to disclose it.

Ms. Joe would add that the whole purpose of this list is so applicants or licensees that are renewing their licenses would know what the Board is going to consider. She said if they have one of the listed crimes, the Criminal Offender Employment Act requires that the Board consider the length of time since the crime happened and if there has been any rehabilitation.

Ms. Joe would go on to say that if the specific felony conviction is on the list, there is not going to be an automatic denial of licensure. Ms. Joe added that the Board is not allowed to have a blanket statement about the types of conviction and there does need to be a specific list.

Mr. Bohannan suggested that the list should be reviewed every two to three years.
